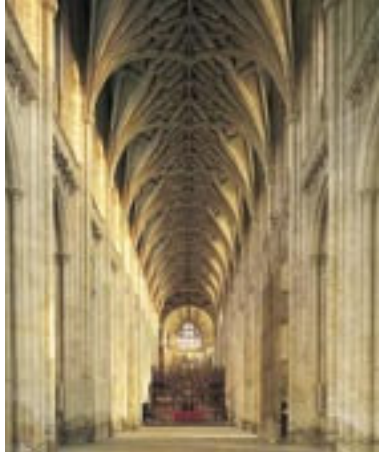
Another local tour of just over 1 hour, exploring the places that will forever remind us of this tragic disaster.

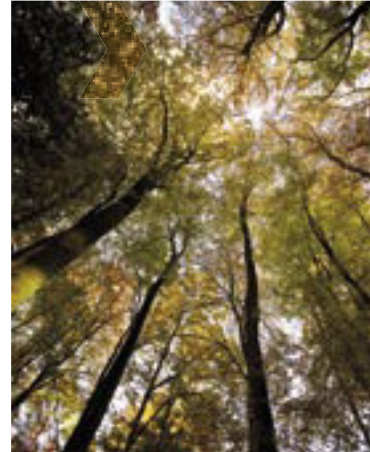
BROADLANDS, ROMSEY & STONEHENGE
